

WUMP BACKGROUND

- Demand management tool since 1985
- Ensures adequate pressure and volume during landscape irrigation season
- Works in conjunction with Water Efficiency Master
 Plan and Landscape and Irrigation Performance
 Standards and Criteria
- Brought to Castle Rock Water Commission each year






- Watering schedule is in effect May through September
- Residential watering is allowed every third day,
 before 8 a.m. or after 8 p.m.
- Non-Residential watering is allowed on a fixed three days per week, after 10 p.m. through 6 a.m. the following day
- Violations can be issued for wrong day, wrong time and water waste

<u>Residential</u>	Non-residential
1 st – Warning, no surcharge	1 st – Warning, no surcharge
2 nd - \$25 surcharge	2 nd - \$100 surcharge
3 rd - \$50 surcharge	3 rd - \$200 surcharge
4 th - \$100 surcharge	4 th - \$400 surcharge
5 th - \$200 surcharge	5 th - \$800 surcharge
Subsequent - \$200 surcharge	Subsequent - \$800 surcharge
Subject to service discontinuance	Subject to service discontinuance
	1 st – Warning, no surcharge 2 nd - \$25 surcharge 3 rd - \$50 surcharge 4 th - \$100 surcharge 5 th - \$200 surcharge Subsequent - \$200 surcharge


WUMP UPDATES

- Remove "Class II" compost
 - Class I compost is a more desirable amendment for Castle Rock soils.
- Remove Section 5
 - All references to registration for landscape professionals and soil inspections are being consolidated to the Landscape and Irrigation Performance Standards and Criteria Manual.
