These also come from Castle Rock residents and neighbors surrounding the proposed project site, all of whom strongly oppose the development of a 24-7 gas station/car wash/convenience store at the corner of Plum Creek Parkway and Lake Gulch Road.

In closing, I would also like to say that during this unprecedented time, as our citizens are overwhelmed with layoffs, how to pay their bills, feed their families along with the emotional toll of isolation and a brand new way of living, I suspect that most individuals are very pre-occupied. We have tried to get the word out as much as possible and these pages contain our limited success as previously described. We feel that there are many more that will be impacted that have not yet been reached. However, from our experience, the overwhelming majority is <u>against</u> this proposal as currently written.

I hope that you do not take any low online "turnout" to mean that citizens do not care or do not object. I hope you recognize that these 183 people are voicing their concerns even if they do not speak or comment separately for the public hearing. Please make sure you do not disregard their voice. I am submitting these signatures on behalf of the signers for the April 21, 2020 Town Council meeting. I am submitting these as scanned electronic files and will also send the original signature pages to the Town Clerk through mail or drop-off.

Attachments: Please find the attached 170 signatures from in-person and online petitions. These come from Castle Rock residents and neighbors surrounding the proposed project site, all of whom strongly oppose the development of a 24-7 gas station/car wash/convenience store at the corner of Plum Creek Parkway and Lake Gulch Road.

Signatures: These signatures were collected by a group of residents who met after the February 27 planning commission meeting because we were very concerned that this proposed project was going forward without adequate outreach and input from residents most effected. Our efforts in canvassing were abruptly halted less than two weeks later due to the COVID-19 emerging distancing requirements and then "stay at home" orders.

Signees were not knowledgeable about this proposal: Those that canvassed repeatedly provided feedback that each interaction took at least 15 minutes because no one we spoke to while canvassing had a full understanding of what was being proposed. Many signees thought that whatever was being built, it was a done deal because of the existing ongoing construction activities for the Plum Creek expansion. Of all the homes that we visited in person, there were <5 who did not object to the project.

More community input is needed: We fully believe that there is a much larger group of residents that we were not able to reach due to the COVID-19 issues that would also object to this project in its current proposed form. Being unable to outreach door to door, we set up an unmanned petition station on private property on the corner of Baldwin Park Rd and Valley Drive. As an unmanned station, this station received 70 signatures alone. That would mean that there is a very large volume of people who walk, bike, stroll their children and walk their dogs (and who don't need to be breathing in even more car exhaust, noise, high traffic) or it means that this project is objected to more by residents than the Castle Rock Town Council understands, or most likely both.



Community has a large number of "interface" concerns: In addition to the list of concerns already submitted to the Town Clerk by certified mail and included below, we have serious concerns that this zoned business plot is not actually zoned for a 24-7 gas station/convenience store/car wash. Residents will be submitting information on these concerns separately. We can do better informing citizens: The lack of understanding as to what was being proposed to residents directly affected by this project reflects poorly on the towns outreach and education efforts.

These signatures represent the voice of your constituents, people who firmly believe that the proposed development at this location does not "interface" with the surrounding community.

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
