Time for a checkup? As long as you are well and not of high risk (over age 65 or having certain health concerns), it's now OK to leave home for dentist and doctor appointments. This not only ensures you're taken care of but also supports these critical local services, which were generally closed under the "stay at home" order. Be aware that you'll need to approach your appointment a bit differently, with masking, symptom checks and virtual (in-car) waiting rooms currently required.

Check with your provider on any questions on their current protocols.

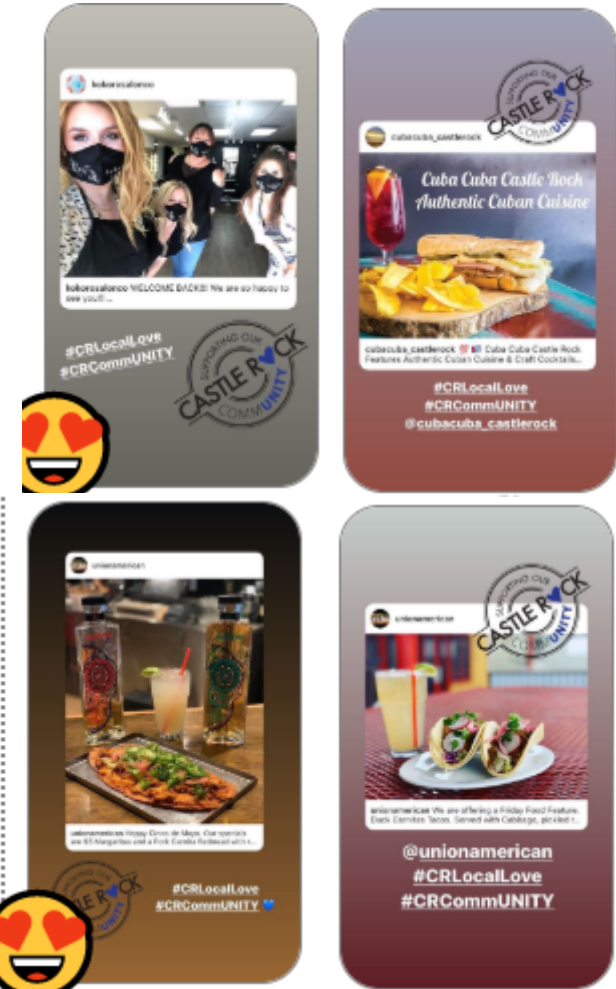

Best Practices for All Businesses

Worksites

- Deputize workplace coordinator(s) charged with addressing COVID-19 issues.
- Maintain 6-foot distancing when possible, and discourage shared spaces.
- Frequently sanitize all high-touch areas.
- Post signage for employees and customers on good hygiene.
- Ensure proper ventilation (OSHA guidance)
- Avoid gathering more than 10 people in common areas (e.g., break rooms, etc.) of more than 10 people.
- Implement screening of employees and customers (e.g., temperature screening or health questionnaire).
- Eliminate shared spaces (e.g., individual workstations, shared machinery).
- Provide and encourage use of face coverings to customers & employees.

Reopening Tips

6 Observe 6-foot distancing measures (i.e., marked space in check-out lines)

Encourage use of protection (like gloves, masks, and face coverings) to customers & employees

Provide hand sanitizer at entrances and other high-traffic locations

Implement special hours for vulnerable populations

No more than 10 people in a facility at one time, at a maximum of 50% occupancy

Perform routine cleaning and disinfecting of frequently touched surfaces

Require employees showing any symptoms or signs of sickness, or who have been in contact with known positive cases to stay home


Ensure proper ventilation

Post Good Hygiene signage for employees and customers

Designate workplace coordinator(s) charged with addressing COVID-19 issues
