SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE OPTION TO PURCHASE AND RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL REGARDING GROUND WATER RIGHTS, EASEMENTS AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS

This SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE OPTION TO PURCHASE AND RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL REGARDING GROUND WATER RIGHTS, EASEMENTS AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into this ______day of May, 2020 by and between the Town of Castle Rock, a Colorado home rule municipal corporation by and through the Town of Castle Rock Water Enterprise (the "Town" or "Seller") and Dominion Water & Sanitation District, acting in its capacity as a Water Activity Enterprise ("Dominion" or "Buyer"), (jointly "Parties").

<u>RECITALS</u>:

WHEREAS, the Town and Dominion entered into that certain Intergovernmental Agreement for the Option to Purchase and Right of First Refusal Regarding Ground Water Rights, Easements and Related Improvements dated March 5, 2019 ("Agreement"), whereby Dominion has the right to exercise its option to purchase certain water rights, easements and appurtenances underlying the Cherokee Ranch & Castle Foundation property in Douglas County, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town and Dominion desire a time period of ninety days to negotiate another approach to the option payment currently due June 3, 2020, for the groundwater rights that will potentially be mutually beneficial to the parties.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement as set forth below.

AGREEMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set forth in the Agreement and herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Town and Dominion agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 1.4.2 is hereby amended to read: On <u>Sept. 3, 2020 for the first option payment</u>, and on each subsequent <u>June 3</u> thereafter during the Option Term, Dominion shall pay directly to the Town \$115 per acre foot of the amount of the Arapahoe Water Right remaining for purchase and \$78 per acre foot of the amount of the Denver Water Right and LFH Water Right remaining for purchase to maintain its Option ("Annual Option Payment"). Such Annual Option Payments shall continue until either (a) Dominion purchases all of the Water Rights, or (b) the Option Term expires, or (c) Dominion relinquishes its option on any remaining portion of the Water Rights by giving written notice to the Town, or (d) the Option terminates by mutual agreement of the Parties. The Annual Option Payments shall be non-refundable to Dominion, and shall not be applicable towards the Purchase Price at the next Closing to occur.

The remainder of Section 1.4.2 is unchanged.

2. <u>General Provisions</u>. The following provisions shall apply with respect to this Second Amendment:

(a) Except as modified herein and by the First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Option to Purchase and Right of First Refusal Regarding Ground Water Rights, Easements and Related Improvements dated 18th of June 2019, the Agreement is in full force and effect and is hereby ratified by the Town and Dominion.

(b) Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Agreement.

(c) In the event of any conflict between the Agreement and this Second Amendment, the terms and conditions of this Second Amendment shall control.

(d) This Second Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which (or any combination of which) when signed by all of the parties shall be deemed an original, but all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement. Executed copies hereof may be delivered by telecopier or electronic mail and upon receipt shall be deemed originals and binding upon the parties hereto, and actual originals shall be promptly delivered thereafter.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto have executed this Second Amendment as of the date indicated above.
