## DRAFT COMMUNICATION PLAN

STAFF SUGGESTS PAUSING WHILE STATE ORDER IN EFFECT

- Following Council's direction on July 14, staff developed a draft communication plan, with messaging proposed to stress:
  - When not mandated by State orders and variances, or by private businesses, wearing a face covering is a choice
    - Choices made whether to wear a face covering should be respected within the community
- Staff suggests pausing implementation of the draft plan, since a State face covering order is
  in effect through Aug. 15 CRPD's response to general violations will focus on education
  - If the State order expires then, Council could provide direction regarding implementation of the draft plan at its Aug. 18 meeting; the TCHD order Council opted out of expires Oct. 24

### **FACE COVERING GIVEAWAY**

COST AND NEED EXPLORED THUS FAR

#### COST

- Branded cloth face masks would be \$3.95 each; unbranded cloth masks are \$2.95 each
- Disposable masks are \$1,050 per 2,000, or about \$0.52 each

#### **NEED**

- Staff worked with the Chamber, Downtown Alliance and EDC to query local businesses
- Roughly 70 businesses responded, and slightly less than half said they could use masks;
   all but a handful said they had no preference or preferred disposable masks
- Based upon responses, a minimum initial order of 10,000 disposable masks is suggested

## **FACE COVERING GIVEAWAY**

#### ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- How many masks to order?
  - Castle Pines gave away 8,000, suggesting the Town could give away up to 50,000 based on population ratios the cost for this many disposable masks is \$26,250
    - Any mask purchases made should be reimbursable under the CARES Act
- Timing for giveaway how soon could the masks be in hand and information be shared?
  - A minimum lead time of two weeks is suggested
- Location and logistics for giveaway
  - Gathering size limitations and social distancing ability should be kept in mind
