
DOMINION IGA

- Town acquired Cherokee Ranch water rights in November 2017 with United W&SD purchase
 - Not readily usable by Town
 - Purchased with intent to sell all or part
- Dominion requested the option to purchase groundwater over time
- Cherokee Castle Foundation has rights to 102 AF of water
- 2020 Option Payment dates extended by amendment to give additional time for this deal



DOMINION IGA KEY TERMS OF FOURTH AMENDMENT

- Exchange of some of the Cherokee groundwater rights for additional WISE infrastructure owned by Dominion
- Dominion will forgo option on 500 AF of Arapahoe groundwater
- Future option payments would still be due June 3 of subsequent years through 2022


DOMINION IGA BUDGET & SCHEDULE

<u>Costs</u>

- Value of the exchange is \$1,774,860
- No money being exchanged
- Water Resources fund will need to make Water fund whole with a monetary transfer

<u>Schedule</u>

• Immediately upon mutual execution of Amendment
