












Revenue



As sales tax returns are due 20 days after the end of the month, this report shows the prior month's revenue.

Communicating results

Sales tax collections for August were down 4.9% percent from the previous year's month, or down \$258,772 compared to August 2019. Year-to-date (YTD) is up 4.4 percent. Staff was anticipating August to flatten some compared to July due to less demand to spending, and it came in lower due to sales tax audit revenue. YTD, the Outlet mall category was down. With retail slowly finding its new normal and opening to the public, staff cautiously anticipates September to be similarly flat Barring a new pandemic spike, retail will have a good increase compared to 2019. During these uncertain times, staff closely monitors trending, including regional trends, and will update Council accordingly.
