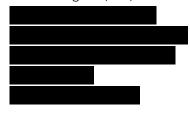

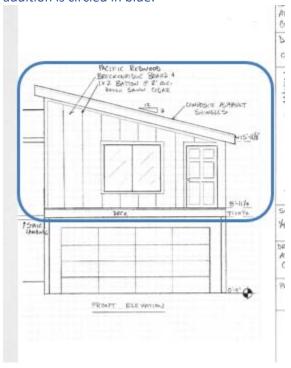

Hi Caryn,

Thank you for your question on what the ADU will look like with the existing home's roof line. As this project will have a public hearing tomorrow night at Town Council, I have included all of Councilmembers on the response, and I will add this information to the agenda packet as well, so everyone has the same information.

The ADU plan for 10 Circle Drive proposes a shed roof design that is typical in residential construction and compatible with gable roofs and dormers. Although the proposed ADU peak height is differing from the existing home, it is below the allowed height allowance for the property. Below is a sketch of the addition over the existing garage. The proposed addition is circled in blue:



Below are two pictures – the first is an image from Google street view, showing the garage on the right:



The owners have made building changes to the existing roofline of the home since the time of the google photo above. Below is a picture of the public hearing sign, and in the background you can see a portion of the existing home and some of the modifications they have made to the porch roof line and existing roof by adding the dormers. In this photo you will also see that they did begin the exterior construction of the addition over the garage a few months ago. Town code does not prohibit them from building an addition on to their home. However the **use as an ADU** is what is up for review at the public hearing. And in this case, the owner did get ahead of themselves and started this construction before their building permit was issued. The did receive a Stop Work Order in September, and are waiting for this use determination on the ADU to be finalized before proceeding with the rest of their construction.



The ADU section of the municipal code regulates whether they can construct this as a separate accessory dwelling unit, with its own living, kitchen, bathroom and sleeping areas. If the use is denied, they can still have an addition constructed over their garage, it will just not be allowed to have all of its own interior uses as listed above for an ADU.
