

Re: Trip Generation Letter Greystone Villas - Castle Rock, CO

Dear Mr. Larrick:

Pursuant to your request Aldridge Transportation Consultants (ATC) has reviewed the trip generation and distribution thereof regarding the proposed development of property on the west





side of Gilbert St. opposite Baldwin Ranch Rd. in Castle Rock. The site is currently undeveloped. The planned development of the property is residential with five villas (townhomes).

Gilbert St. is a two-lane Collector with a painted center left turn lane. It carries approximately 5,100 ADT per the Town's 2017 Transportation Master Plan. The forecasted 2040 daily volume is 5,900 ADT. The posted speed limit is 35 mph.

The site will have one full-movement access to Gilbert St. directly opposite Baldwin Ranch Rd.


Based on the 10th Edition of the ITE Trip Generation Manual, the townhomes will generate average daily and AM and PM peak hour trips per the following table.

The daily traffic generated by the site (37 ADT) is well below the Town's threshold of 200 ADT to warrant a Traffic Impact Analysis. Moreover, the site generated traffic is too small to have a measurable impact on the operations and safety of the adjacent streets and intersections.

In my professional opinion, the transportation facilities are adequate and available to serve the proposed development. No significant improvements are required. The striping on Gilbert St. should be revised to allow the northbound left turn in movement and a slight reduction of the "hook" on the left turn striping onto Baldwin Ranch Road is recommended to clear the path for the left turn movement out of Greystone. The driveway should be constructed to the Town of Castle Rock standards and specifications.
