

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-__

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DECLARED DISASTER BY THE TOWN COUNCIL AND THE TOWN MANAGER

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Town Manager and Council declared a disaster via Resolution 2020-039 as a result of the COVID-19 infectious disease pandemic; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has caused and may continue to cause a strain on the public, the medical system, first responders, and many businesses within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the magnitude of the incident and the response and recovery have exceeded or will exceed operational resources available to the Town of Castle Rock, and all available resources are being or will be utilized or expended; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. 24-33.5-709 and Chapter 2.30 of the Castle Rock Municipal Code, Town Council seeks to continue the declared disaster to June 30, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Emergency Declaration Continuance. The Town of Castle Rock Disaster Declaration due to the national COVID-19 pandemic is effective March 17, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021.

Section 2. Notice. This Declaration shall be given prompt and general publicity, and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk and Recorder, the Town Clerk, or another authorized recordkeeping agency, and the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (CDHSEM).
