# 2020 FOURTH QUARTER CCGP

## PROPOSAL

- No submissions for the 2020 Fourth Quarter CCGP
- \$4,500 - 2020 CCGP unspent funds
- October 2020 – Town Council awarded 2021 PSMRGP funds to five organizations
- Four out of five applicants/orgs received less than requested
- Due to community needs during the pandemic, staff recommends allocation of unspent 2020 CCGP funds to the 2021 PSMRGP recipients
