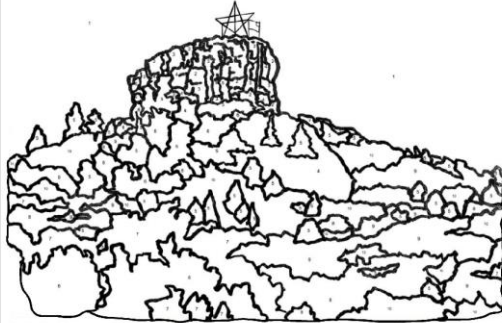

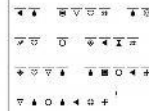

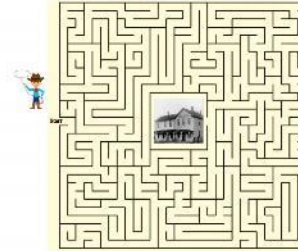
Match the symbols to the big secret code in the Castle Rock Maze below!



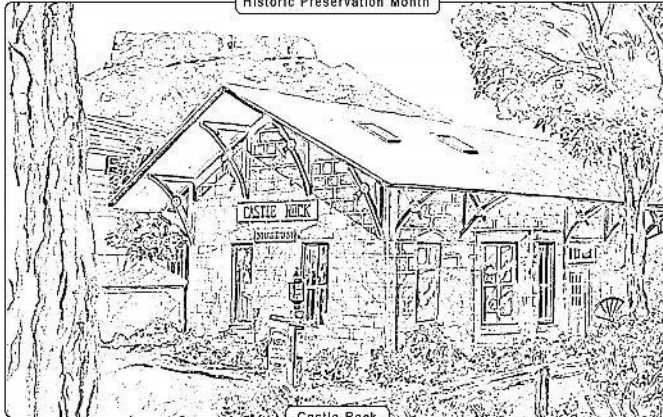

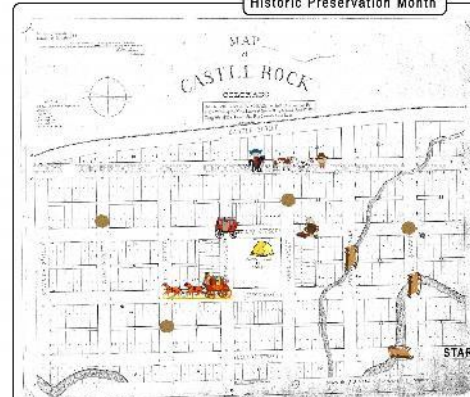

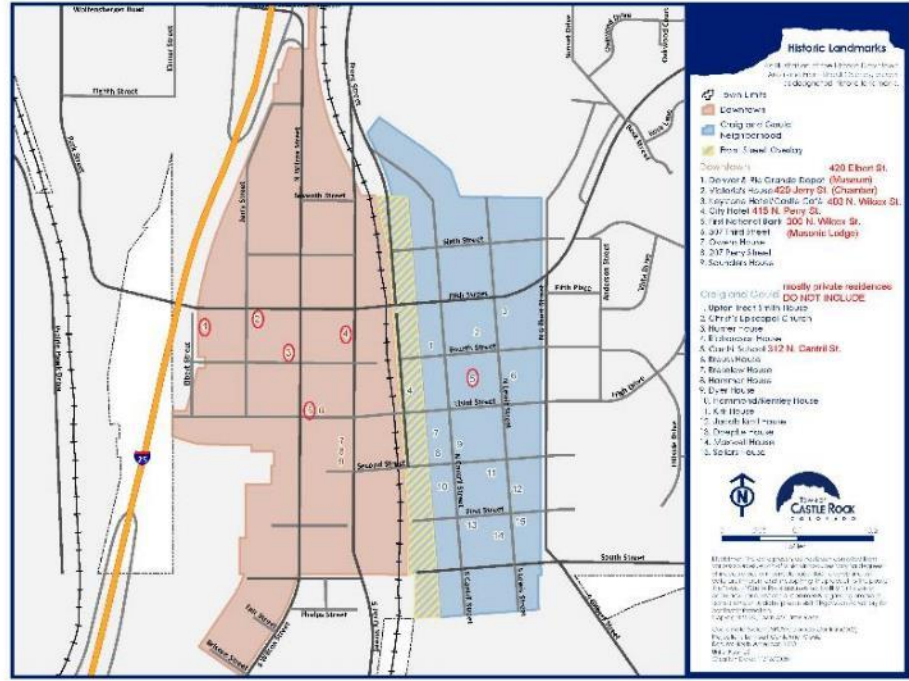
