HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD (HPB)

Membership (CRMC 15.64.030)

Seven members: voting

- Town Council appoints
- Preference to professionals with expertise in historic preservation
- Preference to Craig & Gould's property owners
- Must live in Douglas County, Town residency preferred

One Town Council Liaison: non-voting

 Request for One Liaison from the Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum: non-voting

COLLABORATION WITH CASTLE ROCK HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND MUSEUM

Society's Mission: "To operate the Castle Rock Museum, celebrate educate, and bring together people interested in the preservation of the heritage of the Castle Rock Colorado area."

Town's HPB has worked closely with the Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum staff

- Historic Preservation Month promotion (every May)
- Promotion of Museum events
- Walking Tour brochures
- Landmark plaques and QR codes

APPOINTMENT OF NON-VOTING LIAISON

Desire to foster a stronger, more collaborative relationship between the two boards

- Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum Board would recommend their non-voting liaison
- Town Council appointed
- Same 2-year terms as the Historic Preservation Board members

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum Board supports approving proposed ordinance.
