Castle View Band Boosters	\$500	 Replace 13-year-old drum carriers for the marching band percussion line with state-of-the-art, lighter and sturdier carriers that will cost \$3,500 Castle View High School band has performed at the Douglas County Fair Parade, Night to Shine and other events in the community
Douglas Land Conservancy	\$500	 Support for educational outreach programs, some in partnership with the Town, to offset cost of presenters and educational speakers Over 1600 residents and more than 120 volunteers participate annually to make meaningful connections with open spaces in the region
