
Accounting






This graph illustrates how many business licenses are issued per month, by area.


REVENUE



As sales tax returns are due 20 days after the end of the month, this report shows the prior month's revenue.


Communicating results

Sales tax collections for July were up 8.1 percent from the previous year's month, or up \$415,648 compared to July 2020. Year-to-date (YTD) collections are up 19.2 percent compared to the same time frame in 2020. Staff will continue to monitor this very important revenue stream for the Town and inform as needed.
