RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE FIFTH STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Denver Regional Council of Governments selected the Town of Castle Rock (the "Town") as a recipient of a \$3,500,000 grant of Federal funds (the "Grant") pursuant to the Colorado Department of Transportation's ("CDOT") Stewardship Agreement with the Federal Highway Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Grant enables the Town to apply for reimbursement of \$3,500,000 of construction costs associated with the Fifth Street Improvements Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Town is required to contribute a minimum of fifty percent matching funds for construction; and

WHEREAS, the Town and CDOT have agreed to terms and conditions by which the Town will undertake construction of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Funds</u>. The Town Council has appropriated sufficient funds for the Project from the Town's current Capital Improvement Program. The Town Council intends to authorize the expenditure of funds necessary to meet the terms and obligations of the State of Colorado Intergovernmental Agreement (the "Agreement").

Section 2. <u>Approval</u>. The Agreement, attached as *Exhibit 1*, is hereby approved. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Town.
