# DESIGNATION OF AREAS OR ACTIVITIES OF STATE CONCERN


- At the September 21, 2021 meeting, Town Council designated the following activity of state interest:

Site selection and construction of major new domestic water and sewage treatment systems and major extensions of existing domestic water and sewage treatment systems located wholly or partially within the Watershed Protection District as designated on the Watershed Protection District map

# DESIGNATION OF AREAS OR ACTIVITIES OF STATE CONCERN

- At the meeting, CR Water Director Mark Marlowe informed the Town Council of his intention to expand the Watershed Protection District Map to include territory occupied by the Town's waterworks and water supply in the Cherry Creek Watershed
- In accordance with the requirements of Castle Rock Municipal Code Section 4.02.020, the official Castle Rock Watershed Protection District Map has been updated administratively
