### <u>RES 2017-036</u> Resolution Approving the Town of Castle Rock Services Agreement with HB&A, LLC for Construction Document Preparation Services [For Parks and Facilities Maintenance Building]

Sprague presented information regarding need for and location of proposed Parks and Facilities Maintenance Building, and requested Council approval of service agreement with HB&A to prepare construction drawings so the project could be put out to bid this summer.

#### ID 2017-022 Update: Preliminary 2016 Unaudited Year-End Financial Review

Corliss reviewed highlights of preliminary (unaudited) financial reports, noting

revenues were approximately 3% above budget, and expenses were also below budget. Noted initial projections indicated the Town's revenue would be below the TABOR cap for 2016, so there was no issue of excess revenues.

### ORD 2017-011 Ordinance Approving Supplemental Appropriations for 2017 and the First Amendment to the 2017 Budget Authorizing Changes for Year 2017 (First Reading)

Muller reviewed proposed first amendment to 2017 Budget. Noted approximately \$81 million of amendment resulted from carry over of funds previously appropriated in 2016 for various capital projects. Noted all of these projects were previously approved by Council. Reviewed the request for supplemental appropriations totaling approximately \$4 million.

Green moved, seconded by Ford, to approve Ordinance No. 2017-011 as presented on First Reading.

#### DIR 2017-007 Discussion/Direction: TABOR 2015 Revenue Proposed Expenditures

Corliss noted staff had prepared a list of recommended, one time expenditure items for use of the 2015 excess TABOR revenues voters authorized the Town to retain in 2016.

Cauley, Morales and Goebel reviewed the proposed expenditures within the areas of public safety, emergency medical service and transportation improvements.

Townsend moved, seconded by Teal, to approve using the 2015 TABOR Revenue as authorized by voters in the November 2016 election for public safety, EMS and transportation expenditures as outlined.
