Ms. Vossler presented the application for the proposed rezoning of Dawson Trails Planned Development Plan. Though not acted upon by the Commission, Ms. Vossler highlighted several items in the Development Agreement. Ms. Vossler reviewed the community outreach efforts and feedback received. Ms. Vossler provided the plans and technical criteria on which the Commission should consider for this application. Staff recommends that Planning Commission recommend approval of the Dawson Trails Planned Development to Town Council, as proposed, as it meets all criteria.

Commission but will be considered by Town Council with respect to the Dawson Trails Planned Development.

Mr. Marlowe, Director of Castle Rock Water, answered questions of the Commission.
