<u>SUMMARY</u>

The application is for a Change in License Type to a Tavern Liquor License from Kambsland, LLC dba The Backyard located at 330 Third Street.

The members of Kambsland, LLC dba The Backyard are:

Matt Frary Kelly Kambs Corbin Wanninger

The operating manager that will oversee the day-to-day operations of the business is: Corbin Wanninger

- The application for the Change in License Type to a Tavern license was submitted to the Town Clerk's Office on July 5, 2022.
- Fingerprints were completed by the Applicant and manager and forwarded to CBI for clearance showing no history affecting the issuance of a liquor license.
- The application was submitted to the State for their approval on September 21, 2022.
- In accordance with State law, the property was posted with a Public Hearing Notice on October 13, 2022; and a Public Hearing Notice was published in the Douglas County Newspress on October 13, 2022.
- Town Staff has reviewed all documents required to apply for a license, and has found them to be complete and in compliance with State Statute, Liquor Regulations and Town Code.
- Petitions reflecting the needs and desires of the neighborhood that includes adult inhabitants and businesses within a one-mile radius of the premise have been submitted, and 97% of those questioned favor issuance of the license.

• The business will continue to operate under the Beer and Wine license until the state approves the Tavern license.
