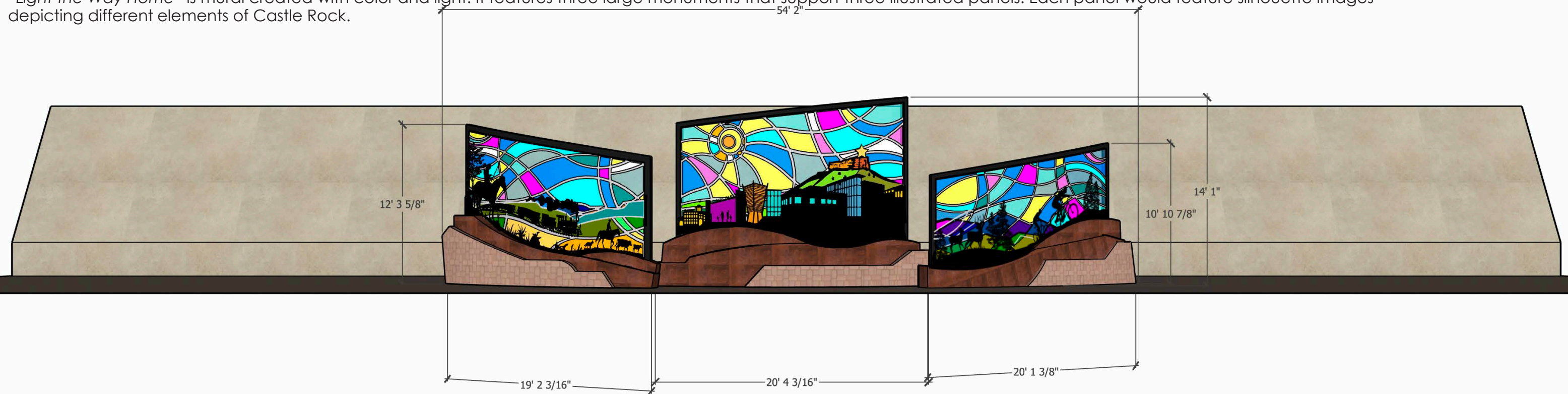

“Light the Way Home”

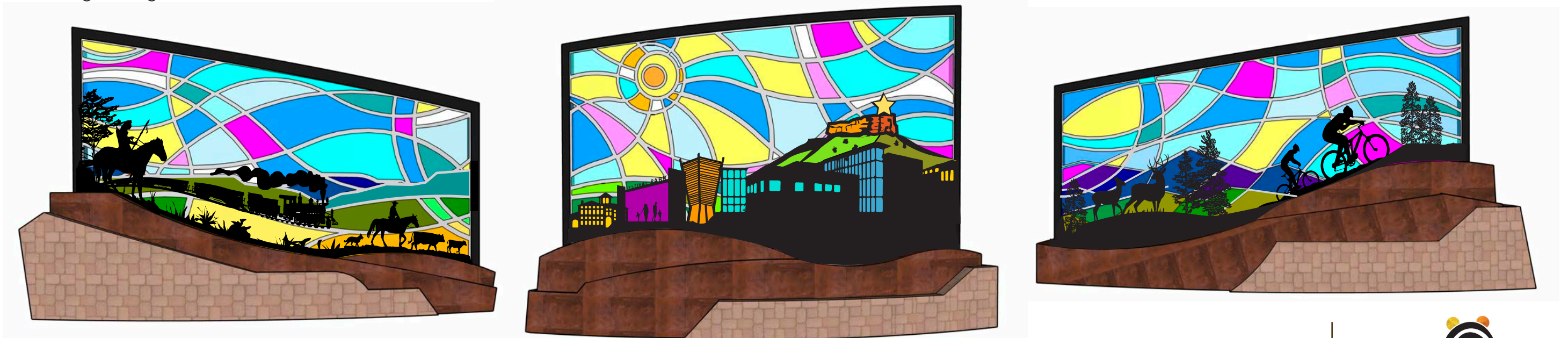
“Light the Way Home” is mural created with color and light. It features three large monuments that support three illustrated panels. Each panel would feature silhouette images depicting different elements of Castle Rock.



Panel 1 would depict images from the Castle Rock's history, and could include Native American history, ranching, mining and the railroad.

Panel 2 would depict images from the modern, thriving town of Castle Rock.

Panel 3 would depict images of outdoor recreation and the natural environment.



*NOTE! The design shown are for concept only. For sake of time at this stage, much of the imagery was borrowed from clip art and on-line sources, including Castle Rock's own town website. Final designs with original illustrations will be developed for the panels if the this concept is chosen to move forward.

**A community input session could be included to help come up with desired imagery.



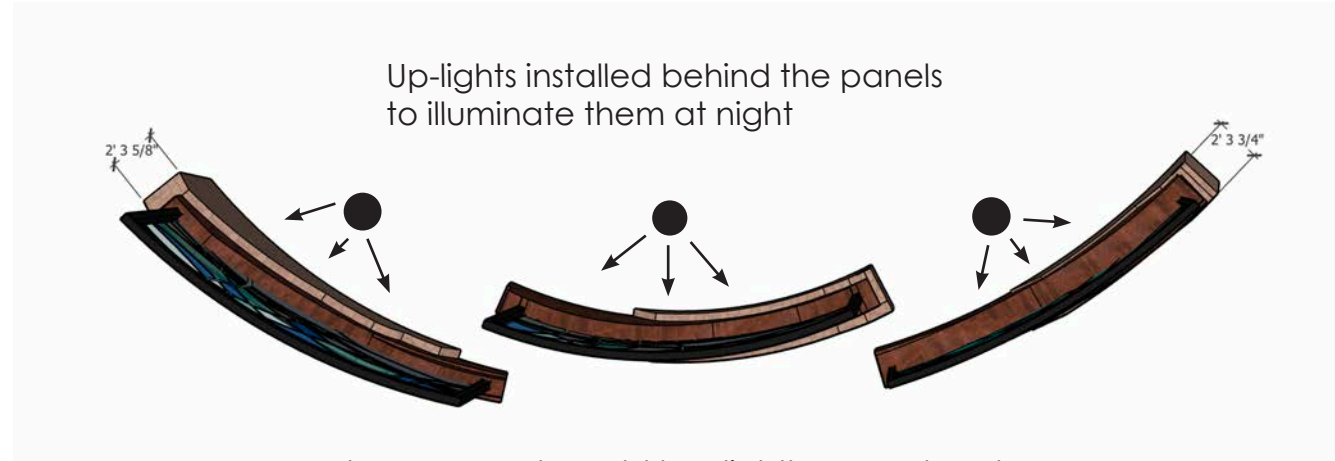

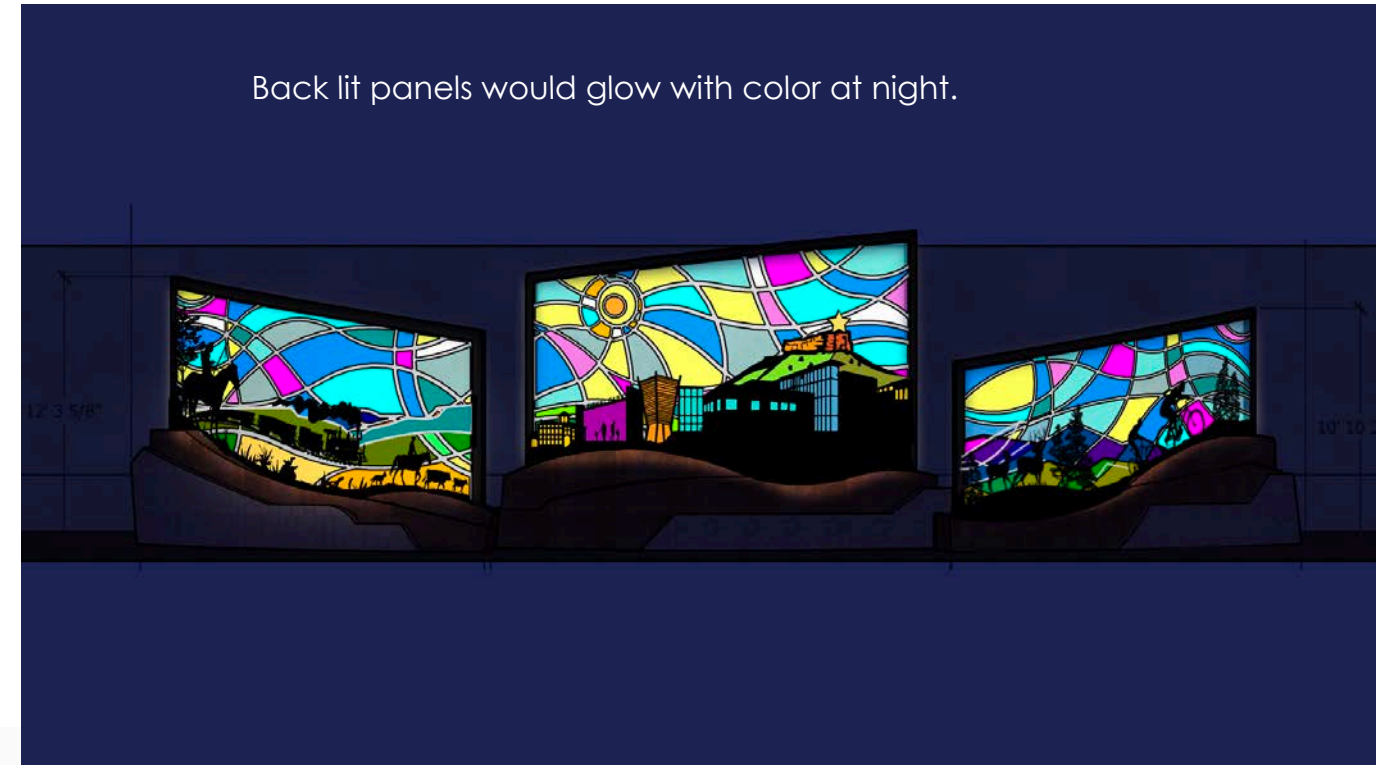

Each monument would be slightly curved and arranged in a semi-circle.

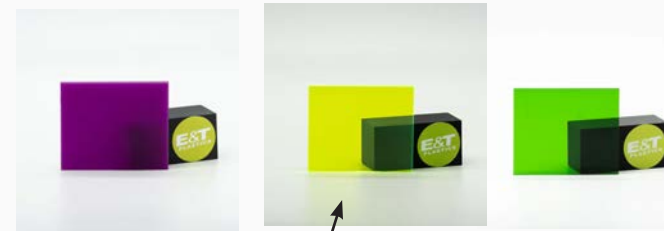


View approaching from the north, looking south.
